A Late Pick-Up Fee of one dollar (\$1.00) per minute will be assessed for pick-ups after 6:00 PM or pick-ups that are 30 minutes or more after the school has closed early due to inclement weather. I/We understand and agree that the service shall be provided for the period of the entire school year (September to June). I/We agree and understand that the payment procedure, interest assessment, if needed, as well as the collection process and procedure will be the same as described in the separate tuition contract for the above child. I/We understand and agree to assume full responsibility for the entire fee due as stated above, unless cancellation of this Agreement is made in writing. I/We understand and agree that the School retains the right to exclude any child from participating in any activity that, in the considered judgement of supervision teachers, the child is not yet ready to participate in safely or where the child's participation at the time in question may interfere with the health or safety of others.

I/We have read the written materials prepared by The School that describe the program and understand the program is subject to change or cancellation at the discretion of The School at any time. I/We have read the above terms and conditions and fully understand and agree to abide by all the conditions and terms of this Agreement. This Agreement must be signed personally by both parents or guardians of the above named child, if applicable. Be certain to include the date when you sign this Agreement. This Agreement is not binding until signed and accepted by The Barrie School.

**Program:**

The Barrie After School Supervision Program for 4<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> graders will provide both child care for Barrie students who need to remain on campus for the afternoon and enrichment programs for those Barrie students who would like to participate in school-sponsored programs or receive study support from teachers. Based upon principles of best practice in both independent school and Montessori after school programs, our program “strives to model the large family consisting of multi-aged siblings, watched over by caring adults who lead by example, express interest and affection and try to help the students maneuver the labyrinth of social interactions they face each day” (Carrington, Montessori Life, Issue 3, 2007). Barrie Middle School teachers will staff both the supervision and enrichment activity sections of the program.

Details of enrichment and programmatic activities in addition to the above will be sent prior to the start of the school year.

Middle School and Upper Elementary students may not remain on campus unless they are under the supervision of an adult. Students waiting on campus for an activity run by the Athletic Department must be under the supervision of either a coach or the Athletic Director. Students waiting on campus for theatre activities must be under the supervision of the Drama Department. Students waiting on campus for other athletic events may only do so with the express permission of the Middle School Head.

Students are permitted to drop into Supervision free of charge during the time their parents are attending a scheduled meeting with teachers or administrative staff, either on a regular school day or on a Conference Day.

**Fees and Payment:**

Late Pick-Up Penalty Fee: A late fee of one dollar (\$1) per minute is assessed for 1) pick-ups after 6:00 PM, or 2) pick-ups that are 30 minutes or more after an early closure of school due to inclement weather.

Drop-in Charges: A drop-in charge of \$30 per day is assessed when 1) a student joins an Extended Day group without permission and 2) a request for drop-in usage is received the same day the drop-in is to occur.

**Professional and Conference Day Programs:**

On Professional Days and Conference Days, supervision of students is offered in the Lower School gym from 8:00 AM to 5:30 PM for children in the Primary and Lower Schools. However, children in the 2/3 Class are not eligible. Enrollment is limited to thirty children on a first come-first served basis. Students who are enrolled in the daily After School Supervision program are not automatically enrolled into these programs. A form and special fee must be submitted for all students who will use the program. The fee is \$60 for the first child and \$46 for each sibling. Enrollment forms are sent home by way of classrooms two weeks before the Professional Day. We do not offer a program on days when school is closed for a national holiday or a religious observance.
