

# Barrie Camp Overnight Registration Form (for Weeks 1, 2, 3, and 4)

**Campers are eligible for Overnights if: 1) a Registration Form is properly completed and signed by a parent or guardian, 2) the correct fees accompany each Registration Form, and 3) a current and complete Health Form is on file in the Camp infirmary.**

**Directions:** 1) indicate the Overnight dates in order of preference, 2) read the "Acknowledgement of Risks" below, 3) sign and date the form, 4) write a separate check for each Overnight, 5) **Return this form as soon as possible, even if your camper will not begin camp until Weeks 2, 3, or 4.** A lottery will be held when the number of applications exceeds the number of spots available on any Overnight. Parents are sent emails confirming their camper's enrollment in an overnight. A separate overnight registration form for Weeks 5, 6, 7, and 8 will be sent to camp families on July 11. Do not use this form to enroll in overnights that occur during weeks 5, 6, 7, or 8.

### • Acknowledgement of Risk •

In consideration of the services of Barrie Camp, their officers, agents, employees, and all other persons and entities associated with it, I agree as follows:

~ Although Barrie Camp has taken reasonable steps to provide campers with the appropriate equipment and skilled staff so they can enjoy activities for which they may not be skilled, I acknowledge that field trips, camp-outs and overnight trips are not without risk. Certain risks cannot be eliminated without destroying the unique character of the activity. The same elements that contribute to the unique character of these activities can be causes of loss or damage to my child's equipment, accidental injury or illness. Barrie Camp does not want to frighten my child or reduce my child's enthusiasm for the activity, but thinks it is important for parents and their children to know in advance what to expect and to be informed of the inherent risks.

~ Barrie campers live, camp and travel out of doors, where they are subject to numerous risks, environmental and otherwise. Activities vary on field trips, camp-outs and overnight trips, and include hiking, swimming, canoeing.

~ Sites for field trips, camp-outs and overnight trips are chosen with the availability of emergency care and location of medical facilities in mind. However, communication and transportation are difficult and sometimes evacuations and medical care may be delayed.

~ Meals are prepared over gas stoves and open fires. Camping hazards may include burns, cuts, diarrhea and flu-like illness, and falling timber.

~ Travel is by vehicle, canoe, horse or on foot. Attendant risks include collision, falling, capsizing and others usually associated with such travel, as well as environmental risks.

~ Environmental risks include deep or cold water; insects, snakes, and predators; lightning, flash floods and unpredictable forces of nature, including weather which may change extremely without notice.

~ I am aware that my child's participation in field trips, camp-outs and overnight trips entails risks. I understand that the description of these risks is not complete and that other unknown or unanticipated risks may result in injury. My child's participation in these activities is purely voluntary, no one is forcing my child to participate, and I give my child permission to participate in spite of the risks.

~ I certify that my child is fully capable of participating in this activity. Therefore, in the event of my child's negligence while participating in these activities, I assume full responsibility for my child for bodily injury, death, and loss of personal property and expenses thereof.

~ I hereby give permission to the medical personnel selected by the camp director to order X-rays, perform routine tests, and give treatment for my child, and in the event I cannot be reached in an Emergency, I hereby give permission to the Physician selected by the camp director to hospitalize, secure treatment for, and to order injections and/or anesthesia and/or surgery for my child.

**-I understand there will be no refunds or credits if: 1) for an on-campus overnight, the camper named above withdraws within 24 hours of the overnight, or, 2) for an off-campus overnight, the camper named above withdraws within 48 hours of the overnight.**

**-I have read and understood the "Acknowledgement of Risks" stated above, and hereby give permission for my son or daughter to attend the Overnights listed above.**
