Swimming Level Standards

Level	Standard	Restriction	Skills
WA - non-swimmer (Water Adjustment) (Lower Camp)	Does not go underwater	Must Stay within the roped off 2 ft. area	Ability to go under water.
Level 0 (Lower Camp)	Adjusted to water. Goes underwater and is comfortable jumping into the water.	Must Stay within the roped off 2 ft. area	Floating, opening eyes underwater, learns to complete similtan and alternating leg and arm action.
Level 1	Adjusted to water. Goes underwater and is comfortable jumping into the water.	Must stay within the 3 1/2 ft. pool signs. Permitted to swim along 3 ft. wall and up to wooden guard chair.	Floating, opening eyes underwater, introduced to skills needed for front crawl.
Level 2	Can complete all skills and Standards in Level 1 with proficiency.	Permitted to swim up to the flags (approx. 4 ft. depth)	Continuation of skills required for front crawl; maintain front to back and back to front floating positions.
Level 3	Can complete all skills and standards from Level 1 and 2 with proficiency.	Permitted to swim the entire length of the pool - no restrictions.	Front and back glide with kicks, mastery of front crawl and back-stroke with breathing techniques.
Level 4	Can complete all skills and standards from levels 1 through 3 with proficiency.	Permitted to swim the entire length of the pool - no restrictions.	Refinement of skills taught in Level 1 through 3. Skills practiced through water activities.
