Registration Information

- ◇ **Registration:** To register your child for an enrichment program, please see the attached enrollment form.
 - ◇ **Payment:** Payment for programs is due before the second class session. Payment can be made via check (payable to Barrie School) or credit card. Participants with an outstanding balance may be removed from the program.
 - ◇ **Pick-Up:** Following class, students who have not been picked up will be taken to Barrie School's Extended Day program. Please reach out to Tim Evans at tevans@barrie.org for students in Grades 1 - 8. **Space is not guaranteed. Drop in rates apply.**
 - ◇ **Cancellation and Refunds:** If a program is cancelled due to low enrollment, families will receive a full refund for their students. Families who wish to remove a student from a program prior to its start must be done at minimum three business days in advance of the start of that particular program. A partial refund, excluding a \$25 registration fee, will be returned if cancellation is three days prior to the start of that program. There are no refunds for any cancellation after a program has begun. In the event that a class is cancelled due to inclement weather, families will be given a refund for the class session missed if the class is unable to be made up at a later date. There are no refunds if a class is missed due to a student's absence.
