#### **Registration Information**

- Registration: To register your child for any program, please see the enrollment form. Piano lessons can be scheduled by emailing apalmer@barrie.org. Karate has a secondary enrollment form, including the opportunity to purchase an optional uniform.
- Payment: Payment can be made via check or credit card. Payment is due prior to the second class. Students with an outstanding balance may be removed from the program.
- Karate: P4 and P5 students enrolled in Karate will go from their classroom to car pick up before being escorted by the instructor to the Strauss Gym for Karate.
- Students Staying After a Program Ends: If your child remains after a program is scheduled to end, they will be taken to their respective Extended Day Program. Should you need your child or children to stay with the program, please reach out to Abby Palmer at apalmer@barrie.org for students in Grades 1-8 or Jennifer Protil at jprotil@barrie.org for P4 and P5 students. Space is not guaranteed. Drop in rates apply.
- **Cancellation:** If a program is canceled due to low enrollment, families will receive a full refund for their child/children. Families who wish to remove a child from a program prior to it's start must be done at minimum three business days in advance of the start of the program. A partial refund, excluding a \$25 registration fee, will be returned if cancellation is three days prior to the start of that program. There are no refunds for any cancellation after the program has begun.


