General Responsibilities:

- Lead and manage a group of 15 to 20 campers

 - Special Events
- Assist and care for the needs of campers throughout the camp day
- Report camper issues immediately to the appropriate Unit Director
- · Assist Specialists at each activity area
 - Guide and encourage camper participation
 - Participate appropriately in all activities
- Sit or stand as a lookout when at the Pool
- Assist with camper arrival and dismissal procedures
- Maintain a friendly and professional relationships with all camp staff and parents
- Lead a *team* of counselors
 - Mentor Junior Counselors and Counselors-In-Training
- Participate in at the minimum of one overnight during the summer
 - o Participate in more than one overnight when called upon
- Implement safe, interesting and engaging free-time activities
- Participate in all staff training sessions and staff meetings
- Maintain a safe and healthy camp group by following:
 - Written safety procedures
 - Health regulations
 - Operating guidelines
- Identify and report environmental and other hazards when seen
- Sign in and out daily in the camp office
- Other duties assigned as needed
