Robotics — Mondays

Location: Elementary Makerspace

Timing: 4 – 5 PM

Frequency and price: 7 classes for \$175

Eligible for: 1st – 3rd grade

Dates: April 15, 22, 29, May 6, 13, 20, Jun 3

Here's a fun introduction to the world of robotics and mechanical engineering, designed especially for grades 1 - 3. We'll learn what programs do and how to write our own. Each class meeting, we'll build a different project and then use motors, sensors, and our own programs to bring our creations to life! We'll build crawlerbots, windmills, planes ... and more!



Tiny Chefs – Wednesdays

Location: Upper Elementary Building

Frequency and price: 8 sessions for \$225

Timing: 3:30 PM – 4:30 PM

Eligible for: 1st—5th grade

Dates: April 3, 10, 17, 24, May 1, 8, 15, 22



At every Tiny Chefs class children learn how to measure, pour, mix and stir while being free to use their creativity. Kids show a sense of pride when they can make something with their own hands. Learning all about 3-course meals is what this session is focused on! We took our best summertime favorite American Cuisine recipes, used them as the basis to create an All-American Diner the campers will use to model their own restaurants, and then threw in a Chopped!-style twist, forcing the students to deal with a restaurateur's worst nightmare—the wrong ingredients being delivered to their café! If your Tiny Chef dreams of being the next Bobby Flay or Rachel Ray, or competing on Top Chef, this is the after-school program they are looking for!

This may occur if 1) the program is at capacity, 2) the enrollment form was received after the due date, or 3) there is an outstanding balance due for other enrichment programs in which the student has already participated.

Payment:

Please make out a check for the amount due to “The Barrie School” and return it with this form to Dan Hayden or Sue Wentzel in the camp office (contact info is below). Payment is due by the second class.

Cancellation:

After participation in the first week of the program tuition is non-refundable unless there is 1) a demonstrable medical condition preventing the Student from continuing in the program (requires written letter from the Student’s doctor) or 2) the Student has withdrawn from Barrie School.

Liability Waiver:

I/We, the undersigned, parent(s) and/or guardian(s) of the child attending this class (the Student), hereby consent to the participation of the Student, in this program. If the Student should befall any injury entering, during, or leaving the class, I wish for the Program Instructor to take appropriate steps to immediately notify the parent or emergency contact listed above. In the event that the emergency contact is unreachable, I authorize the Program Instructor to take any and all necessary steps to obtain medical treatment for my Child. I/We further discharge and release the provider offering the program and its employees or Barrie School and its employees from any and all liability for injury, loss, damage, obligation, expense, or penalty sustained by the Student arising out of or in connection with the Student’s participation in the class.
