



Barrie Prep After Prom 2019: Expectations and Permission

All students participating in After Prom are expected to adhere to the three Barrie ideals:

- respect for self
- respect for others
- respect for the environment

Students participating in After Prom are expected to adhere to the behavioral expectations as communicated in the Family Handbook and outlined in the Barrie Prep Disciplinary Procedures.

These include:

- maintaining the highest standard of personal integrity and honesty;
- demonstrating an on-going appreciation of our community's commonalities and differences;
- speaking respectfully and politely to faculty, staff, administration, fellow students other volunteers; this includes avoiding inappropriate language and innuendo; and,
- being responsible for one's own possessions and be respectful of the personal property of peers, Barrie faculty, staff, administration and associated program providers.

The behaviors that result in the harshest disciplinary measures, including being sent home from After Prom, suspended from school activities, and/or jeopardizing participation in end of school activities including the Graduation ceremony, are:

- possession of firearms or other weapons, or toys resembling firearms or weapons
- purchasing, possessing, using, distributing or being knowingly in the presence of any drug or alcohol activity while participating in After Prom
- purchasing, possessing, using, distributing or being knowingly in the presence of any drugs (prescription or non-prescription) not registered with Barrie's Health Services; and,
- the use of homophobic, negative racial, religious, sexist, or other remarks made with the intent of demeaning or harming community members.

Guests of students who attend Prom are also eligible to attend After Prom. Barrie students who invite guests must complete the online Guest Registration form seven days prior to the After Prom. See the Upper School Dean for details. Barrie students are responsible for staying with their guests during After Prom and ensuring their guests meet behavioral expectations outlined above.

After Prom runs from 11:30 AM to 4:30 AM. To ensure safety of all students, we will stop admitting students to After Prom by 12:15 AM, and students who leave the Barrie Center during After Prom will not be allowed back into the event.

Upon arrival Barrie students and their guests will be asked to check coats, bags and dress clothes (where applicable) with Barrie staff and After Prom parent volunteers. After Prom participants are encouraged to bring a change of clothes for After Prom. These will be returned at the inclusion

To ensure safety of our students, we strongly encourage them to be picked up by an adult by 4:30 AM. See below* to identify the person who will pick up your student.

Barrie staff will notify the families of any student who leaves After Prom early and is not picked up by a parent, guardian or the person listed on the form below.
